Largest baseball memorabilia collection outside Cooperstown

**Additional Points of Interest.** **Old Las Vegas Mormon Fort Historical Park**  
Las Vegas Blvd meets Washington Ave.  
Not free, but it only costs \$1 for adults and children are FREE. Tuesday - Saturday: 8a-4:30p

**Additional Points of Interest.** **Neon Museum and Boneyard Outdoor Walking Tour**  
Freemont Street Experience  
Outdoor Neon walking tour is free.  
Daily: 24 hours  
(Boneyard Neon Outdoor Tour costs \$15 pp, available Tue-Sat)

**Additional Points of Interest.** **Hot Springs**  
Nevada has more than 300 natural hot springs throughout the state. The non commercial developed are free.

**Additional Points of Interest.** **Extraterrestrial Highway (Near Area 51)**  
Nevada is home to Area 51, regardless of whether or not the government admits it. The famous Extraterrestrial Highway is actually 92 miles long and is located about 150 miles north of Las Vegas. (Nevada State Route 375 on your map)

**Additional Points of Interest.** **Pioneer Saloon**  
Goodsprings NV (35 miles south of Las Vegas)  
The oldest bar in southern Nevada with a ton of history in this old building which opened for business in 1913.
